TRANSPLANT LINERS

POT SIZE: Quart (1 litre), 1-gallon (4 litre)

MEDIA: Porous soil with good drainage

VERNALIZATION TRIAL RESULTS: Vernalization is not required for flowering. However, in our trials, bulked and vernalized plants performed better with more flowers on a much fuller plant. Vernalized plants will bloom earlier than unvernallized plants.

GROWING ON

MEDIA pH: 6.0 to 7.0

MEDIA EC: 1 to 1.2 mmhos/cm

MOISTURE: Plants should not remain wet. Do not overwater, but do not allow to wilt hard.

FERTILIZER: Constant liquid feed of 100 to 150 ppm nitrogen is sufficient while actively growing.

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING Long days are beneficial for flowering, but not required. Temperature: 60°F to 65°F (13° to 18°C) night and 65° to 80° F (18° to 27° C) day is sufficient.

COMMON PESTS: Aphids, spider mites

COMMON DISEASES: Botrytis

Pinching: Pinching is not required in liner phase, but pinching is encouraged to prevent blooming in trays.

CROP MAINTENANCE: Can shear after flowering and will get some rebloom.

GROWTH REGULATORS: Not necessary

SCHEDULING RECOMMENDATIONS

Transplant unvernallized liners into finished container in late summer to fall to bulk plants prior to vernalization. Vernalized liners planted in spring are only recommended for quart (1 litre) production. Allow plants to flower in spring with naturally occurring temperatures. If moving to
