License for propagation is required

TRANSPLANT LINERS

POT SIZE: Transplant liners into 1-gallon (4 litre) or 6- to 8-inch (15 to 20 cm) pot with one cell per pot.

MEDIA: Porous soil with good drainage is important.

VERNALIZATION: Not required for flowering.

GROWING ON

MEDIA pH: Optimum not tested. Standard for 1-gallon (4 litre) pot is 5.5 to 6.5.

MEDIA EC: Optimum not tested. Standard for 1-gallon (4 litre) pot is 1.0 to 3.

MOISTURE: Do not allow plants to dry out and wilt. This will cause irreversible damage to foliage and developing flowers and buds.

FERTILIZER: 100 to 150 ppm nitrogen constant liquid feed.

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Long days required for bud initiation. Not necessary to provide extra light when grown outdoors June to September.

TEMPERATURE: If finishing in the greenhouse, heat to 68°F (20°C) is sufficient.

COMMON PESTS: Foliar nematodes and root knot nematodes for Anemone genus. None seen.

COMMON DISEASES: Rhizoctonia. **GROWTH REGULATORS:** None trialed.

COMMENTS: Color fades inside greenhouse.

Extreme heat will delay flowering.

VARIETY FEATURES

- Long-lived garden plants great for mixing with garden mums, including the perennial Igloo Dendranthema Series, and other fall flowering perennials.
- Two double and two single flower forms in pink and a white single form.
- Large flowers over 2 inches (5 cm) wide
- Compact habit unlike other *Anemone* hupehensis



SCHEDULING RECOMMENDATIONS

Plant unvernalized liners in late May to early June for flowering plants in late September into early October. In our Lancaster, PA Zone 6 trials, pots grown under shade cloth were slightly ahead of plants grown in full sun. Do not suggest planting later than June 15th.

CONTAINER STATISTICS

LIGHT: Full sun to part shade

FLOWERING HEIGHT:

'Pretty Lady Diana', 'Pretty Lady Emily', 'Pretty Lady Julia', 'Pretty Lady Maria':

18 inches (46 cm)

'Pretty Lady Susan': 12 inches (30 cm)

GARDEN STATISTICS – 3rd year

LIGHT: Full sun to part shade **HEIGHT**: 24 inches (61 cm) **SPREAD**: 24+ inches (61 cm)

USDA HARDINESS ZONE: Zone 5 to 9.

Comments:

These are spreading plants in the garden. Requires moist soil in garden, not tolerant of very dry conditions.
