TRANSPLANT LINERS

POT SIZE: Transplant liners into 6- or 8-inch (15 or 20 cm), or standard 1-gallon (4 litre) pots with one cell per pot.

MEDIA: Porous soil with good drainage.

Vernalization Trials: Vernalization trials are executed by placing cell flats in a cold greenhouse set at 38°F (3°C). Fluctuations in temperature occur based on natural day and nighttime temperatures in Lancaster, PA, USA.

VERNALIZATION TRIAL RESULTS: Vernalized liners will provide increased flower count and vigor. Will flower without vernalization

GROWING ON

MEDIA pH: 5.5 to 6.5

MEDIA EC: 1.5 to 3 mmhos/cm

MOISTURE: Plant should be grown moderately moist. Do not let plants wilt hard.

FERTILIZER: While actively growing, plants perform well with a constant liquid feed of 100 to 150 ppm nitrogen.

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Not required for flowering.

TEMPERATURE: In our trials, liners were planted outdoors in April; 60° to 75°F (16° to 24°C) average recommended.

COMMON PESTS: Shore fly and fungus gnats

COMMON DISEASES: Bacterial leaf spot

GROWTH MAINTENANCE: None

GROWTH REGULATORS: None

VARIETY FEATURES

- Medium-pink flowers with hot pink veins are 1-inch (2.5 cm) in diameter
- Forms dense mounds of attractive green foliage
- Great garden presence. Blooms heavily in June with some rebloom in September through frost



SCHEDULING RECOMMENDATIONS

Plant unvernalized liners in spring for full flowering pots in 11 weeks. For increased vigor and flower count use vernalized liners. Vernalized liners finish in about 9 to 10 weeks after transplant.

SPECIAL FEATURES

Lovely pink flowers with hot pink veins on mounding deep-green foliage. Fantastic presence in the garden. Cut back hard in late summer. Allow enough time for new growth before winter.
